

COSCA Communications Chairman Report for 2025 Barry Robert (Bart) Forbes December 10, 2025

Overview: January 1, 2025, to December 10, 2025

During 2025, up to December 10, 2025, the Communications Chairman has focused on four major projects: Scottish Connections Fund Application, Tartan Crew: Future of the Scottish Heritage Community, the new COSCA Genealogists Forum, and creating two new online databases that link all the National Trust for Scotland heritage sites with specific clans and families.

These projects are in addition to his usual duties: posting twenty-two (22) public blogs, adding 48 additional Society News items, distributing 12 monthly *COSCA Updates* (which are opened by an average of over 500 people each month), increasing COSCA's audience on social media (23% increase on Facebook and 80% on Instagram), and directly communicating with 69 Scottish heritage societies (sometimes several representatives from the same society), 7 Businesses, 7 Nonprofits, and 49 Individuals.

B. Clearinghouse

COSCA has added two online databases during this period: 81 clan and heritage sites managed by the National Trust for Scotland and 393 families and clans that have a connection to each of these properties. (See: Appendix A: National Trust for Scotland Heritage Sites.)

These are have been added to the COSCA Clearinghouse on the website that also includes twelve (12) other databases: Associations (now 162 up from 161), Chiefs (171), IRS Clan Societies (now 154, up from 153), Clans and Families (344, up from 343), Clans/Families Facebook Pages (152, up from 151), Games (177), Lifetime Memberships (70), Society News (now 212, up from 186), Scholarships (59, up from 58), Surnames (now 11,178), and Scottish Law (33). COSCA now provides a listing of Clan and Family Gatherings in Scotland. Currently, 25 Gatherings are listed.

C. Society News

Every month, the Communications Chairman scans over 200 Facebook pages and society websites to research news items from clan and family societies, local Scottish heritage associations, and games organizations. As a result, 48 additional <u>Society News</u> items were posted during this period for a total of 217. (See Appendix B.) This not only keeps COSCA informed of the activities of current and potential members but also demonstrates our keen interest and support of these groups. COSCA now receives news items directly from these organizations. See Appendix B: Society News.

D. COSCA Updates

In the beginning of each month, the Communications Chairman compiled and distributed an e-mail newsletter called "COSCA Update:"

E. Social Media

During this period, the Communications Chairman wrote and distributed 23 public Facebook posts and 22 Instagram posts. During this period, COSCA had a cumulative reach of over 1,414 on Instagram and over 11,041 on Facebook. The Instagram account now has 437 followers, up from 241 followers in December 2024, an increase of over 80%. COSCA Facebook posts have generated a total of 1,656 followers, up from 1,345 followers in December 2024, an increase of 23%. About 54% of Facebook followers are female. F. Website Audience

During all of 2024, the website attracted 23,204 users, 159,740 views, and 273,671 event counts. During this period, the COSCA website attracted 32,709 users (up 41%), 172,005 views (up 8%), and 339,386 event counts (up 24%). The most visited pages were the Surname search page (34,896 views from 8,260 users), Find My Clan (20,898 views from 8,950 users), the Clan Map (15,139 views from 10,288 users), and the COSCA homepage (7,762 views from 4,097 users).

Of the total users, 17,831 (54%) came from organic searches (such as Google), 7,360 (22%) from a direct link (such as the QR code), and 5,804 (18%) were acquired from social media (such as Facebook). See Appendix D: Google Analytics.

G. Outreach

The Communications Chairman has reached out to Scottish heritage societies in several ways. He has donated to or joined nine clan & family societies, specifically those representing Forbes, Stewart, Campbell, Buchanan, Morrison, Irwin, Burnett, Bell, and Logan. He is currently engaged with seven Group Chats: Maclean, Scott, MacQueen, Clans of Scotland, Donnachaidh, Ewing, and Logan. The Chairman of the Clan Irwin Association invited him to participate in its Annual General Meeting on April 26. He presented a brief overview of COSCA Communications Projects from 2024 and an update on current projects. The meeting was very productive for COSCA since two prospective Organizational Members were identified (MacKay and Fiddes), the Treasurer agreed to write a finance blog, a member agreed to participate in the Future Project, and contacts were made regarding a future blog on the involvement of the National Trust for Scotland with clan and family societies. Scottish heritage societies have contributed to the COSCA blogs: Clan Buchanan Society International, Clan MacKenzie Society, Clan MacEwen Society, and Clan Irwin Association.

H. National Trust for Scotland

In November 2025, COSCA researched the perception of the National Trust for Scotland (NTS), National Trust for Scotland Foundation USA (NTS-USA, and the Clan Partnership program. Inquiries were sent to over 250 representatives of 42 clan and family societies that represented the families associated with NTS heritage sites or that were members of the Clan Partnership program at one time. Most of the responses expressed their gratitude to COSCA for compiling the databases of the NTS Clan Heritage Sites and Clan Heritage Sites by Families. Some offered specific comments. These responses were included in the blog "Limited Partnership: Clan Societies and the National Trust for Scotland." See Appendix E: National Trust for Scotland Research.

I. Genealogical Forum

The Communications Director facilitated the inaugural meeting of the COSCA Genealogist Forum on September 21, 2025. Sean Logan, Genealogist for Clan Logan, and Christine Conlon, Genealogist for Clan Buchanan, approached the Communications Chairman with the idea to create a clan and family society genealogists' forum. The result was the launch of the forum with a COSCA blog on August 17, 2025, announcing the first Zoom gathering on Sunday, September 21. (See: Clan and Family Genealogy Forum Launched.) Twelve clan and family genealogists participated, and they agreed to have regular communications. (See: COSCA Clan Genealogist Forum Charts a Collaborative Future.) The co-chairs have since created a private Clan Genealogists Facebook group and have begun collecting useful information, such as "Roots for Rookies," "So What Does the Society Genealogist Do, Anyway?" and "Clan Buchanan Genealogy Research Guidelines." The group currently has 15 members. (See: https://www.facebook.com/groups/1158929619451074.)

J. Personal Communication

Personal communication is critical for building relationships with current and potential members, and with the public. The Communications Chairman personally communicated with individual representatives of:

- 49 Individuals

K. Scottish Connections Fund Application

The Director of Communications has converted the "COSCA Leadership Guide" project into the "COSCA Academy for Scottish Heritage Societies" and requested funding from the Scottish Connections Fund 2025 to 2026. Here is the short summary included in the application:

As the pre-eminent nonprofit trade association for Scottish heritage societies in the United States, COSCA will provide multimedia educational courses utilizing print, videoconferencing, and online interactive courses to assist societies in areas of using resources from Scotland.org, tracing genealogy with ScotlandsPeople, partnering with the National Trust for Scotland, planning ancestral tours, engaging people aged 21 to 35, welcoming diversity, increasing gender equity, transitioning leadership to a younger generation, and other modern management topics.

The budget for the project includes:

- New Zoom Business account for up to 300 participants is about £160 per year
- Upgrade Wix Website Management account from current plan (£120 per year) to Premium Core (£260 per year) for a difference of £140
- Printing and drop-shipping COSCA Academy student guide (300 books with 90 pages, soft bound, and spiral binding) is estimated at £9.50 per book for 300 books for a total of £2,850
- Packaging and mailing guides are estimated at £1,850

COSCA will provide £2,800 in matching funds in the form of professional services of Bart Forbes. The completed application was submitted on September 5, 2025, and receipt was confirmed on October 8, 2025. See Appendix G: Scottish Connections Fund 2025 to 2026.

L. Tartan Crew: Future of the Scottish Heritage Community

As a result of emails sent to over 200 contacts for current Organizational Members, COSCA recruited six individuals for the Future of the Scottish Heritage Community. Each was interviewed and video-recorded from societies representing Irwin, Bruce, Logan, Scott, Forbes, and Oliphant. Based on these discussions and on research on Generation—Z, the Director of Communications developed a marketing strategy that was launched on August 31, 2025. Specifically:

- "Hang" replaces "join," inviting young people to connect casually rather than commit.
- "Crew" replaces "group," emphasizing camaraderie and shared identity.
- "Tartan" becomes a catch-all symbol for Scottish pride—representing clans, St. Andrew's Societies, Highland Games, and diaspora communities alike.

For the logo, lime green and hot pink dominate the color palette - chosen for their popularity among Gen Z audiences. Since authenticity is key, COSCA spokespeople share personal stories of discovering clan connections, highlight inclusive heritage experiences, and speak in their own voice with no scripts and no filters. To capture their attention, COSCA created new accounts on Gen Z's favorite platforms: TikTok (@Tartan.Crew), Instagram Reels (@Tartan-Crew), and YouTube Shorts (@TartanCrew).

From the interviews, the Communications Chairman created an initial six videos that run less than a minute and are optimized for mobile viewing with captions. Viewers are told to "find your Tartan Crew" on a COSCA webpage that provides links to Highland Games, local organizations, and clan and family societies:

M. Summary

The Director of Communications was appointed in December 2019. He conducted three surveys in 2020, as part of the research for strategic planning. He wrote the *COSCA Strategic Plan*, which was approved by the COSCA Board of Directors in 2021. In that year, he launched the communications activities based on the communications strategies presented in that report.


