COSCA Communications Chairman Report for May 2025 Barry Robert (Bart) Forbes May 16, 2025

Overview: January 1 to May 16, 2025

In the period of January 1 to May 16, 2025, the Communications Chairman has posted 8 public blogs, added 4 members-only articles in the Members Only section of the website, expanded the COSCA clearinghouse of information, added 17 additional Society News items, distributed 5 *COSCA Updates* which are opened by an average of over 500 people each month, increased COSCA's audience on social media (11% on Facebook and 47% on Instagram); launched the Future of Scottish Heritage Community Project with requests sent to over 200 contacts; and directly communicated with additional individual representatives of 40 Scottish heritage societies, 3 businesses, and 19 individuals.

A. Public Blogs

B. Member Services

Four detailed resources were added to the organizational members-only <u>Members Services</u> section of the website that assist Scottish heritage societies in improving their management, communications, and more:

C. Clearinghouse

The COSCA Clearinghouse on the website now includes twelve (12) databases, including Associations (now 161 up from 159), Chiefs (171), IRS Clan Societies (153), Clans and Families (343), Clans/Families Facebook Pages (151), Games (now 177 up from 165), Lifetime Memberships (70), Society News (now 186 up from 167), Scholarships (58), Local Societies (152), Surnames (now 11,177 up from 11,102, and Scottish Law (33). COSCA now provides a listing of Clan and Family Gatherings in Scotland. Currently, 37 Gatherings are listed, up from 33.

D. Society News

Every month, the Communications Chairman scans over 200 Facebook pages and society websites in order to research news items from clan and family societies, local Scottish heritage associations, and games organizations. As a result, 17 additional <u>Society News</u> items were posted during this period. (See Appendix A.) This not only keeps COSCA informed of the activities of current and potential members but also demonstrates our keen interest and support of these groups. COSCA now receives news items directly from these organizations.

E. COSCA Updates

In the beginning of each month, the Communications Chairman compiled and distributed an e-mail newsletter called "COSCA Update:"

F. Social Media

During this period, the Communications Chairman wrote and distributed 9 public Facebook posts and 9 Instagram posts. During this period, COSCA had a cumulative reach of over 369 people on Instagram and over 2,244 on Facebook. The Instagram account now has 354 followers, up from 241 followers in December 2024, an increase of 47%. COSCA Facebook posts have generated a total of 1,491 followers, up from 1,345 followers in December 2024, an increase of 11%. For more details, see Appendix B: COSCA Facebook and Instagram Posts.

G. Website Audience

During this period, the COSCA website attracted 11,620 users and 126,378 views. The most visited pages were the Surname search page (16,936 views from 3,639 users), Find My Clan (9,350 views from 3,899 users), the Clan Map (4,098 views from 2,622 users), and the COSCA homepage (3,150 views from 1,558 users.) Of the total users,7,575 (65%) came from organic searches (such as Google), 2,943 (25%) from a direct link (such as the QR code), and 305 (2%) were acquired from social media (such as Facebook). H. Outreach

The Communications Chairman has reached out to Scottish heritage societies in several ways. He has donated to or joined nine clan & family societies, specifically those representing Forbes, Stewart, Campbell, Buchanan, Morrison, Irwin, Burnett, Bell, and Logan. He is currently engaged with seven Group Chats: Maclean, Scott, MacQueen, Clans of Scotland, Donnachaidh, Ewing, and Logan. The Chairman of the Clan Irwin Association invited him to participate in its Annual General Meeting on April 26. He presented a brief overview of COSCA Communications Projects from 2024 and an update on current projects. The meeting was very productive for COSCA since two prospective Organizational Members were identified (MacKay and Fiddes), the Treasurer agreed to write a finance blog, a member agreed to participate in the Future Project, and contacts were made regarding a future blog on the involvement of the National Trust for Scotland with clan and family societies.

I. Personal Communication

Personal communication is critical for building relationships with current and potential members, and with the general public. The Communications Chairman personally communicated with individual representatives of 40 Scottish heritage societies, 3 businesses, and 19 individuals. J. Leadership Guide

The Director of Communications has compiled all the articles for the guide and is currently working on the layout and illustrations. One key section on finance and investment was provided by the Treasurer of the Clan Irwin Association.

K. Future of the Scottish Heritage Community

The Future of the Scottish Heritage Community Project was launched during this period. On March 9, emails were sent to over 200 contacts for current Organizational Members. See the letter in letter Appendix E. As a result, six individuals were interviewed and video-recorded from societies representing Irwin, Bruce, Logan, Scott, Forbes, and Oliphant. These will be edited down to 30-second videos.

L. Clan QR Banner

At the March 2025 Sherman Celtic Festival and Games in Texas, the Communications Chairman debuted the new banner of Quick Response (QR) codes that link to 140 surnames association with clan and family societies. The banner became a big hit with festival goers who wanted to connect with their Scottish heritage. Mary Erwin, Chairman of the Clan Irwin Association and COSCA Regional Commissioner for the Gulf States, also displayed the banner at 2025 Scottish Tartan Festival in Minden, Louisiana. The banner was also unfurled at the 2025 Colorado Day Festival hosted by Robert Heston, author of the book "Scottish Clans and Their Associated Families." See Appendix F.


